VI. Discussion Items

1. AP Literature and Composition - There are concerns over the border crossing and overnight aspect. A grant was applied for through the Stockbridge Area Education Foundation (SAEF) for \$4,000 for tickets, lodging, transportation and food. SAEF may be on board with tickets. Maybe explore the possibility of a one day trip?
2. Heritage Signage - We need to remove Elementary. It should be Heritage School. Consensus on black lettering 10" size and address numbers moved down 6" or so from where it is. Request to reach out to Johnson Sign in Jackson for an additional quote.
3. Facilities - Hoop house - it is a frame with plastic cover (2 layers) with air blown in for insulation. .29 cent non-condensate 6 mil clear plastic - Suggestion made to check into Consumers Energy for a rebate. Dwayne Watson is also a great resource that would be knowledgeable of other rebates involved in building greenhouses. Suggested to look into automatic louvers. Engineers can plan but do not have them install the greenhouse. It is suggested to look at a 4 ft knee wall. It will help allow more growth and space all around. Get a good commercial grade hoop house. Best direction to face is north to south.
4. Sportsmanship - Our goal is to have each of the stakeholders come in and participate with us. Those stakeholders include bus drivers, our coaches, opponent

coaches and officials.

5. Health Center - Wolgast & Collaborative have provided a blueprint of layout. We are still working on obtaining a commitment from Packard Health.

6. Other Updates - Projects planning on moving forward with : Insulation in the gym storage area could be around \$8,000.

Ball fields are in really good shape. We need to put in clay for home plate and pitcher's mound which will be done in the spring.
